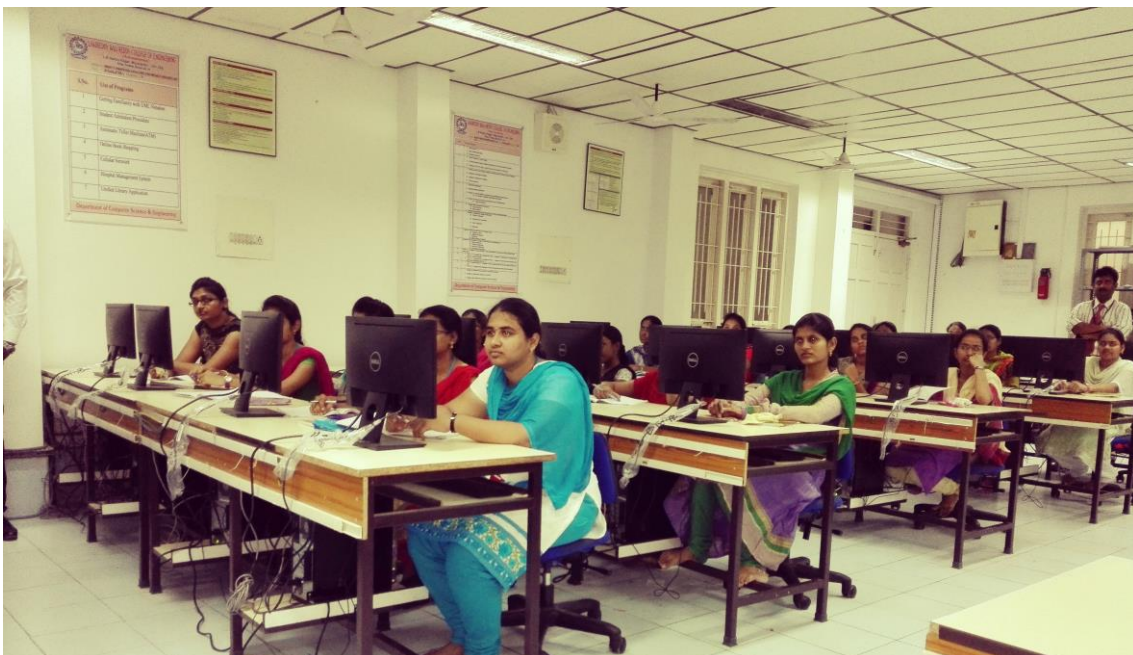

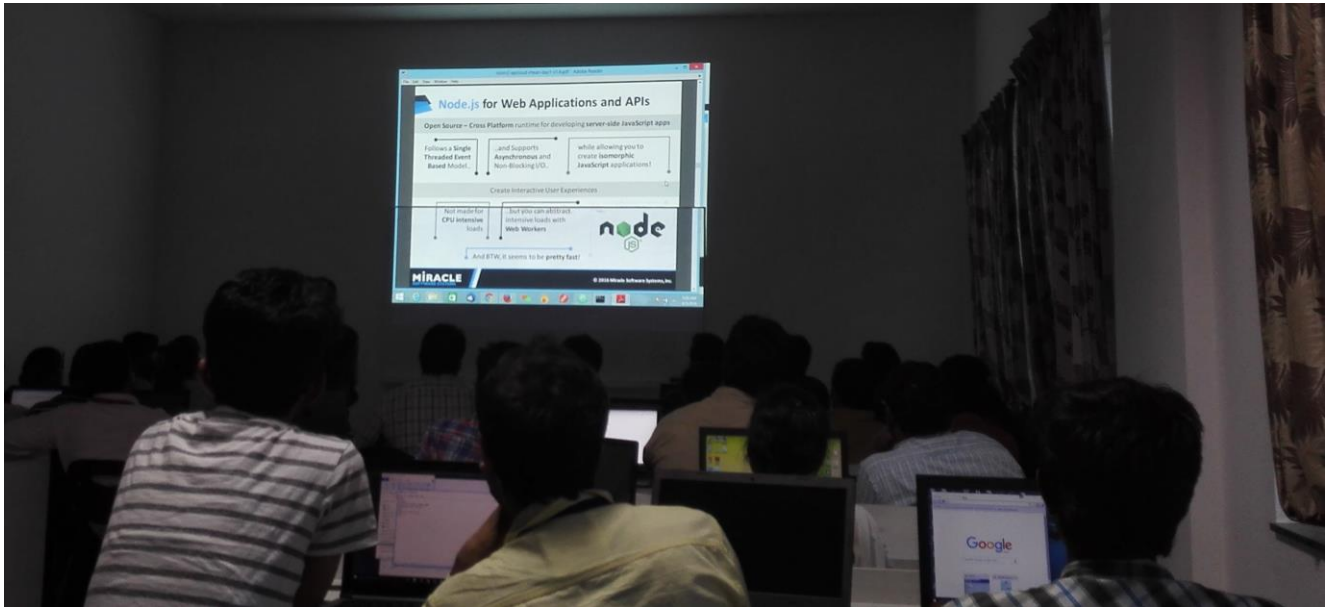
Dr. E.V. Prasad, Director of LBRCE in inaugural of 3-Day Workshop on MEAN Stack

Students in 3-Day Workshop on MEAN Stack Technology & Cloud

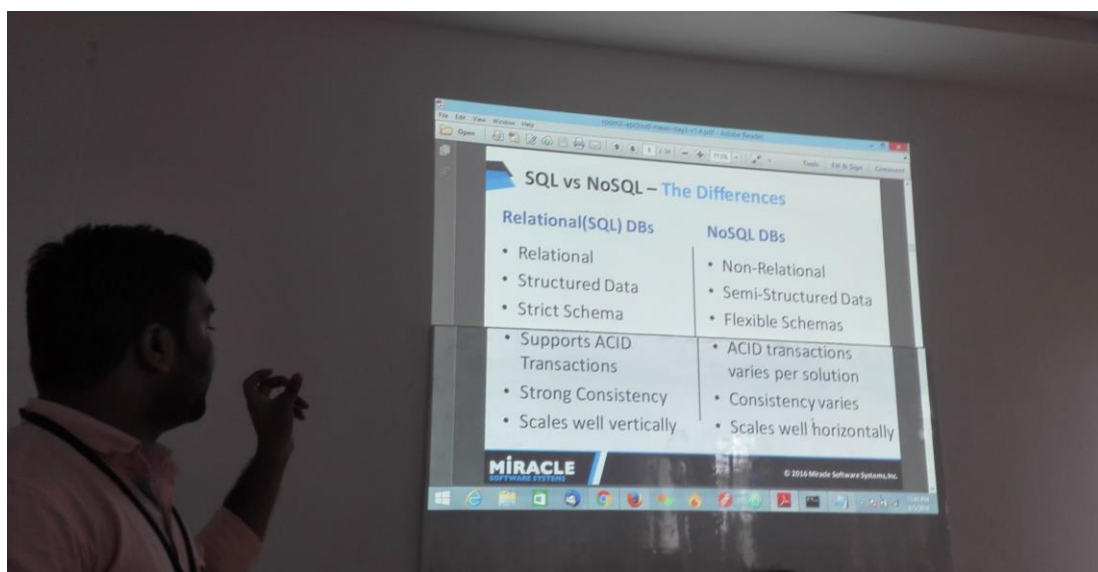


Day 1: Session on node.js

Day 2: 13/09/2016

Our Resource Persons has started their lecture by giving clear insights on Basics of AngularJS, and how the AngularJS is useful in developing SPA (Single Page Applications). Then they have discussed about node.js basics and the various features of the AngularJS. On same day, in hands-on session, they have made the students to create a sample application that performs various CRUD operations.

In the second session, they have taught the students how the ExpressJS provides the simple and beautiful interface for handling the endpoint requests and cookies. Also, they have discussed about differences among SQL and NoSQL Databases. In the hands-on session, MongoDB has been installed in the laptops or desktops, and have done the CRUD operations on MongoDB using queries.

Our Resource Persons has started their lecture by giving clear insights on what is cloud computing, what are the different services offered by cloud, how we can store data in cloud. 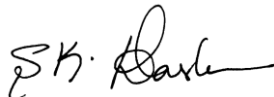
