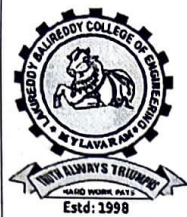

- 4. Review and Discussion on Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) for the Academic Year 2021-22:** The Coordinator reviewed the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) conducted during 30th April to 7th May 2022 in online mode for the A.Y. 2021-22. In the survey, 2934 students out of a total of 4082 students (i.e. 71.88%) participated. GPA is computed for all 20 questions that varies from 3.20 to 3.52 with a cumulative GPA of 3.38 on 4-point scale.

- Student Feedback on Facilities is collected in online mode during the period i.e., 30th April-7th May 2022 for the academic Year 2021-22.
- 2934 students out of a total of 4082 students (i.e. 71.88%) participated in the survey.
- GPA is computed for all 18 questions that varies from 2.73 to 3.37 with a cumulative GPA of 3.07 on a 4-point scale.
