Minutes of the BOS Meeting for B.Tech(Information Technology)

1. Rename the Raptor & MS Office Lab as Raptor & Office Suite. The Office Suite contains the syllabus which covers Word Processor, Spread Sheet, and Power Point.
2. IT Workshop Lab Syllabus to include the topics MS Outlook Express, MS Access, MS Binder.
3. It is suggested that all Applied Mathematics to be renamed as Mathematics.
4. Data Structures Unit-1 & Unit-2 titles to be changed as Searching & Sorting and Stacks & Queues respectively.
5. Digital Logic Design to be introduced in III Semester and Data Communications in IV Semester.
6. It is better to place Operating Systems in III Semester and MEFA in IV Semester.
7. Modifications were suggested for LINUX Programming Subject such that OS and LINUX Syllabi will not have common topics. Also include UBUNTU LINUX as a Case Study in LINUX Programming Subject.
8. The title of the Subject OOP through JAVA may be modified as OOP using JAVA.
9. Learn Object Oriented Programming using JAVA by N.B.Venkateswarlu, E.V.Prasad, S.Chand Publishers may be included as prescribed text book.
10. JAVA: How to Program by Dietel & Dietel book may be adopted as prescribed text book for JAVA Lab Course.
11. It is suggested that OOP through JAVA Lab be renamed as JAVA Lab.
12. It is suggested that Shell Scripting Lab is a better name than LINUX Lab.
13. Minor modifications were suggested in DBMS Theory and Lab Syllabi.
14. RUP may be included into OOAD Syllabus.
15. Data Mining Syllabus be revised and Data Warehousing concepts also to be included. The title of the subject be named as DWDM.
16. It is suggested to explore the possibilities of replacing Bioinformatics Elective with Business Intelligence and Big Data.
17. Distributed Systems Subject can be considered as a possible replacement for Advanced Computing Algorithms.
18. The ANDROID Application Development is felt to be an apt title in place of ANDROID.
19. It is also suggested that Operations Research can be considered as a replacement for ROBOTICS.
20. Cryptography and Network Security is felt to be a more suitable title by the external members than Information Security.
21. The possibility of introducing DAA in IV Semester and SE in V Semester may be explored.
